It was a gruelling 240 miles over 5 days and a huge thankyou goes to him for all his efforts in raising £1360!



The maintenance group worked tirelesly to maintain the camp and they made some major headway with the clearing of a plot of land that we bought last year where the new multi purpose Volunteers House will be. The foundations are set to be built by the end of the year.

Future fundraising will be done to finish the house with ideas already flowing fast!

We had our AGM just a few weeks ago and are proud to welcome new members to the team, this year our membership list is at 53, with 40 of them being students and 45 of them under 25-proof of the incredible young people there are out there!

The Five C's family is growing rapidly and the work we do along with it- we are so happy to have everyone on board and we are looking forward to another year!

We are extremely grateful for all the support that we get, thanks to the Rotary Club of Cardiff Breakfast and the Interact Clubs of Whitchurch and Howells schools that once again supported us all year. Thanks also to all the local businesses and residents who support us, a special thankyou goes to those who have done sponsored events on our behalf. Team leader Owen Moon completed the Tough Mudder challenge raising over £150, team leader Bethan Sexton's mum ran a cocktail and tapas evening rasing over £400, and a friend of the charity, Kyle Greck shaved off his very long locks and raised over £400 too.

It is because of these efforts that work has been able to be started on the new volunteer house in Zabrodie less than one year after we bought the land!
